Re: Professional Curb Addressing Service

Dear Mr. Mendoza,

According to my records Canning Hunger has provided this valuable service twice in the past at no cost to the City or the residents.

**Police, Fire, and Paramedics all agree that a freshly painted, clearly visible curb address can be extremely valuable in an emergency situation, as well as for visitors and deliveries. This is especially true at night when most addresses placed on homes can be difficult to locate or read.**

Canning Hunger offers two options of our curb painting program. In the **donation** option Canning Hunger will provide a professional crew to repaint every residential curb address at **no charge to the City or the resident**. First a City approved door hanger explaining who we are and what we are permitted to do is placed on every residence. A new address is then painted on the curb. Once each address has been checked for quality and accuracy, a Canning Hunger representative personally gives each resident the opportunity to make a tax-deductible donation to help feed hungry kids and their families.

In the second option, Canning Hunger contracts with the City to paint every address for a pre-negotiated price. **No contact is made with residents. License required.**

In both options we do not begin work until all City required permits have been issued. Canning Hunger carries a two million-dollar insurance policy, and uses only approved highway grade materials. **We paint 4 inch black numbers on a white background and add reflective materials for enhanced nighttime illumination.** All of our representatives carry picture identification, a Canning Hunger proof manual, and the City permit.
