**Subject:** OCTA/Senior Meals Transportation Agreement

**Summary:** This report seeks City Council consideration of contract renewal with the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) for Senior Citizen Transportation Services for the one (1) year period from: July 1, 2009 – June 30, 2010.

**Recommendation:** Authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute Amendment No. 14 to Agreement No. C-8-0192, which extends existing transportation services between the City of Los Alamitos and OCTA in an amount not to exceed \$3491.25 for the provision of transportation services through June 30, 2010 for senior citizens participating in the Los Alamitos Senior Meals & Services Program.

## Background

The City of Los Alamitos has contracted to provide transportation to Senior Meal participants since 1986. Many Orange County cities contract with OCTA for this service including the neighboring cities of Cypress, Seal Beach, Stanton and Westminster. The effective term of the agreement is from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010.

This service is provided to persons 60 years of age and older. It is a curb-to-curb service for both ambulatory and handicapped individuals. Transportation reservations for this service are made in person at the nutrition site or by telephone and are available Monday through Friday.

Language in amendment #14 to agreement #C-8-0192 is consistent with previous year changes which will allow for:

1. Extension of the term of the agreement commencing July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 for a one (1) year contract.
2. Vehicle service rate remains at the same rate as last year -- \$9.31 per vehicle service hour (this provides Los Alamitos with a maximum of 375 service hours annually).

3. Payment billing continues on a monthly basis.

***Fiscal Impact***

The contract fee of \$3,491.25 represents the maximum cost of providing transportation to our older citizens during this contract period. This amount provides for the same level of service as provided in FY 2008/09. Appropriation of the funds for this contract amendment is subject to approval of the FY 2009/10 budget.
