**Subject:** Consideration of Revised Resolution 2009-04, Establishing No Parking- Katella Avenue, Lexington Drive to Midway Drive

**Summary:** This item is being returned to City Council to clarify minor changes to the resolution necessitated as a result of differences between the City Council's direction and the actual staff recommendation approved during consideration of this item at the May 4, 2009 meeting.

**Recommendations:** Approve Resolution No. 2009-04, "A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALAMITOS ESTABLISHING NO PARKING-KATELLA AVENUE, LEXINGTON DRIVE TO MIDWAY DRIVE."

## Background

This item was reviewed by City Council at its May 4<sup>th</sup> meeting. During the discussions Council made revisions to the staff proposed parking restrictions. Those revisions provided that the proposed 'No Parking' zones be limited to 15 feet on the west side of the driveways only. As such, a motion from staff was made to revise the resolution where it said 30 feet, to 15 feet. However, the resolution also contained a 'No Parking' zone that spanned over several driveways (*see Attachment 1, Section 2, bullet point 3*). This was not caught by staff during the council discussion on the item. Implementing this provision as written would not be consistent with City Council's direction; therefore, to make sure the record is clear, staff is providing the revised resolution which reflects council's recommendations and is included as Attachment 1.

The original resolution language read "Install red curb from west side of driveway at 4644 Katella Avenue westerly to existing red curb." The revised resolution language breaks this into two separate bullet points, which provide for 15 feet of red curb on the west side of the driveways at 4622 and 4644 Katella Avenue only.

The 'No Parking', red curbing is anticipated to cost around \$500 to install by City forces. Funding is available in the Public Works street maintenance budget.
