**Los Alamitos Municipal Code Section 6.16.100
requires that you keep your dog on a leash
when on any public street, park, or other
public place!**



**Fines and Court Fees
\$295 to \$495**

The leash cannot be more than eight feet long and must be held continuously in the hands of a person capable of controlling the dog!



**Aggressive dogs...
Owners are legally responsible for any injury
caused by their dog.**



**Owners are responsible for picking up after
their dogs.**



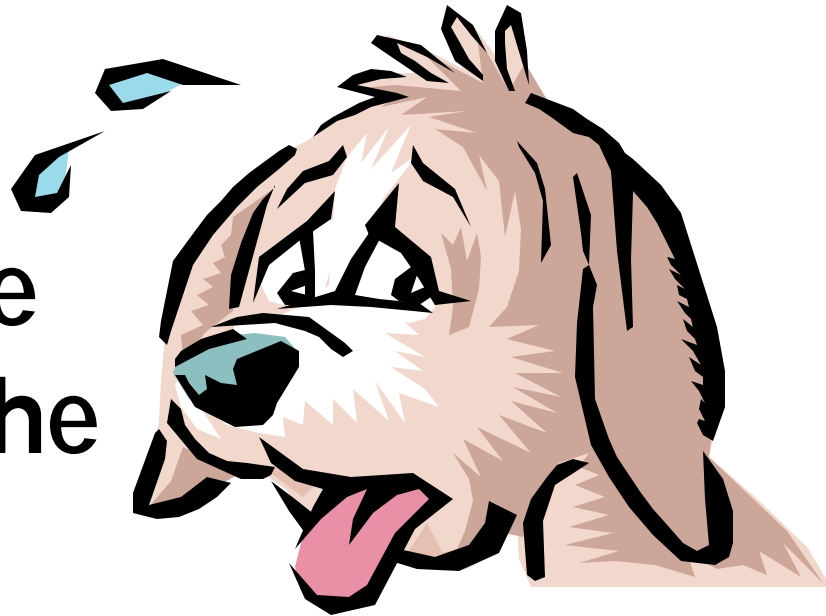

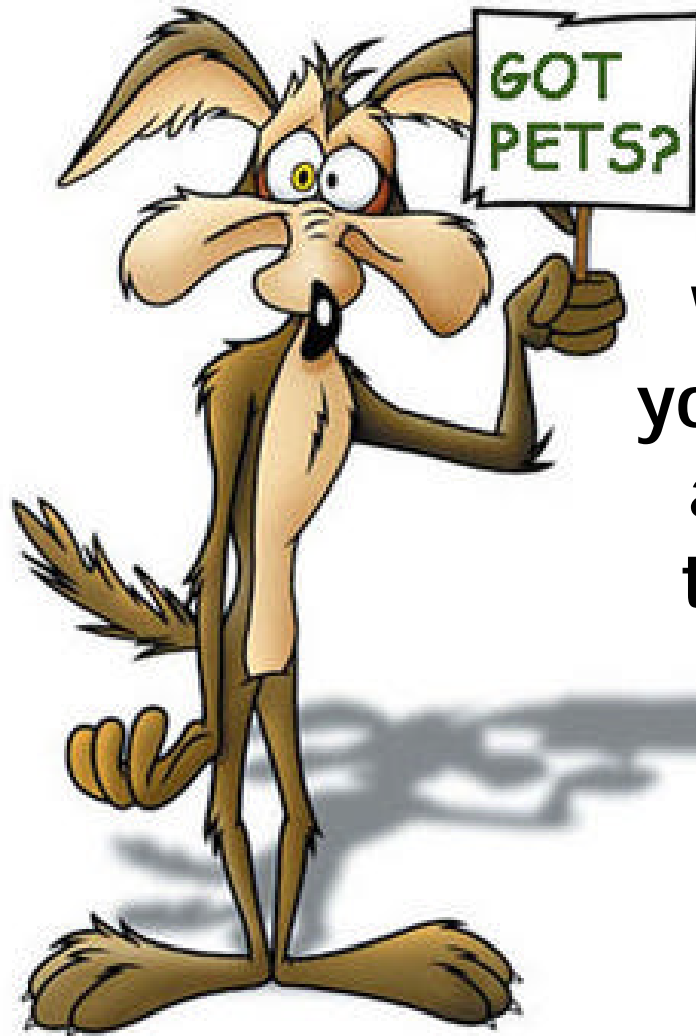
The Police Department receives more calls about dogs that are locked in vehicles than any other animal related call.

Do not leave your dog in the car.



**Los Alamitos Municipal Code Section
6.08.010 requires all dogs over the age of 4
months be licensed.**





When walking your dog, be alert and remember that small dogs are prey to coyotes.
